

404 Error Cheatsheet

Back up your website using your web host backup tools or a backup plugin

Permalinks (Pages/Posts etc)

Disable Caching Plugins
Disable caching plugins

Flush permalink rules
Go to Settings->Permalinks -
Click Save Changes

Assets (images, JS, CSS)

Check file exists
Find the file via FTP/Cpanel
and verify it actually exists

Check file permissions
Make sure permissions are set
correctly on the file

Reset htaccess
Rename your .htaccess file
via FTP

If these solutions don't work, the issue is usually something deeper. Try disabling plugins one-by-one while flushing permalink rules.
